FOR GOVERNMENTAL LEADERS AND AN END TO THE WAR...

Lord of lords and Prince of peace, our politicians are predicting the biggest war in Europe since 1945, and urgently we cry out to you to write another story in our time. Thwart the dark machinations of evil men. Give wisdom beyond human wisdom to peacemakers seeking an equitable and less violent way. May politicians exercise the wisdom from above, which is peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, and full of mercy [James 3:17].[‡]

Suggested Prayer Points[§]

- Pray for an immediate end to the war and that violence would cease.
- Pray that God would change the mind, heart, and plans of President Vladimir Putin.
- Pray for wisdom and strength for Ukrainian leaders, especially President Volodymyr Zelensky, to protect and defend their people.
- · Pray for President Biden and other world leaders to find effective measures to deter President Putin from any further invasion.
- Pray that God would take away the arrogance and hatred which infect human hearts; break down the walls that separate us; and unite us in bonds of love.

For Refugees, Those who Remain, and Especially Children...

You Lord, make wars cease to the end of the earth; you break bows, shatter spears, and burn shields with fire [Psalm 46:9]. We ask you now to save the lives of many people in Ukraine. Establish a peace that is strong and not weak. De-escalate this crisis. We hear of wars and rumors of wars [Matt. 24:6], but you Lord are our rock, our fortress and our deliverer. Our hope is in you. And so we address the nations now. In the name of Jesus we say: "Be still and know God! He is exalted among the nations; he shall be exalted in the earth [Psalm 46:10].

Suggested Prayer Points

- Pray for protection of all, particularly the most vulnerable, including the elderly, children, the disabled and the poor.
- Pray especially for divided families. Men and boys 18-60 are not allowed to leave Ukraine as they have been conscripted into the Ukrainian army.
- Pray for comfort, peace, and strength for mothers who are caring for little children while their husbands are drafted.
- Pray for the displaced and those who welcome them.
- Pray for those who grieve and mourn the loss of property, loss of peace and security, and loss of life.

FOR THE CHURCH IN RUSSIA AND UKRAINE...

Holy Spirit, we pray for the church in Ukraine, a nation in which 70% of the population call themselves Christian. Give our many brothers and sisters in that nation courage in this crisis that they may proclaim the Good News of your Kingdom, bind up broken hearts, and bring comfort to all who mourn [Isaiah 61:1-2].

Suggested Prayer Points

- Pray that God would unite churches across the borders of tradition and state. That the mission and ministry of Jesus would go forth.
- Pray for true healing for all who will experience physical, emotional and spiritual trauma.
- Pray that people would turn to and choose Jesus and that they would experience his hope and peace.
- Pray for missionaries those who were called to stay as well as those who were called to leave.
- Pray that God's will be done on earth that it is in heaven.
